### FROM OUR BY LAWS:

The fiscal year shall be from January 1 through December 31.

(B) The annual dues of the active members shall be payable January 1 and delinquent March 1. The honorary members shall be exempt from dues.

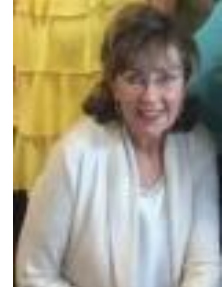

16 went to Sunshine Care Home in Lakeside and the rest went to Country Hills in El Cajon (we had donated to Country Hills thru Love on a Leash in the past). We received a nice thank you card signed by all 16 residents from Sunshine when we were there. I received a call from Country Hills this morning and they will be sending us a thank you as well.
